



D-H and VLACS for Credit Opportunity

Want to earn credit while doing your summer internship?

Dartmouth-Hitchcock has partnered with the Virtual Learning Academy Charter School of NH ([VLACS](#)) to make this possible. Here's how it works:

- You will earn credit by completing applicable competencies.
- You will do your learning through both the DH Internship experience and the VLACS curriculum.
- You will receive a VLACS transcript showing competencies completed and credit earned.

How much does this cost?

- For NH residents that are still in high school, it is free.
- For out-of-NH state residents, the cost is \$486 per half credit.

What are my next steps if I want to register?

1. Enroll with VLACS by the end of your first day in the program.
2. Go to the [Micro-Internship course offering at vlacs.org](#), create an account, and enroll in the offering you are interested in - see suggestions attached.
3. Check with your school to confirm that the VLACS credit will be accepted. VLACS is an approved diploma-granting NH public school and works with all high schools in the state.
